IABC has the resources, connections and learning opportunities you need to move your career forward. IABC/Calgary has great volunteer opportunities to support that.

Volunteering with IABC/Calgary will help you:

- Learn, grow and stay informed.
- Build and accelerate your career.
- Connect with like-minded professionals.

Priority for long-term volunteer opportunities (more than three months) will be given to IABC members. In the event that a volunteer position is not filled by a member, the opportunity may be offered to non-members with the understanding that non-members will be required to become IABC members within six months of beginning a volunteer position.

Casual volunteer opportunities (less than three months) and one-off event support opportunities are open to both IABC members and non-members, however, priority will be given to members.

All volunteers must adhere to the 'IABC Code of Ethics for Professional Communicators' and sign a confidentiality agreement. IABC members volunteering for more than six hours receive 50 per cent off of one event per year, to a maximum value of \$35 for the 2018/2019 season.
